

Ponte Milano, Trebbiano	Light and fresh with aromatic apple and peach notes on the nose and a dry, fresh palate that has an easy-drinking style and plenty of pear, citrus and apple fruit. - Italy	£3.50	£19
Acacia Tree, Chenin Blanc	Fresh citrus and peach flavors with zippy acidity and a refreshing finish. - South Africa	£4	£22
Montevento, Pinot Grigio	A pleasant, fruity wine with notes of pear and floral hints. Fresh, harmonious and well balanced. - Italy	£4.40	£25
Santa Florentina, Organic Unwooded Chardonnay	A fresh, Organic Chardonnay with 'Fairtrade' status to boot! This unoaked Chardonnay is clean and light, with ripe fruit flavors and delicate floral notes. - Argentina	£4.50	£26

Rheingau, Riesling	German wines are extremely versatile, fresh and exuberant and extremely food friendly. Ripe and grapey, characterful, this goes well with light dishes, smoked foods and delicate spice. - Germany		£34
Domaine Millet, Petit Chablis	The nose is classic Petit Chablis; stony and mineral but also lightly honeyed. The palate is tangy with crushed sea-shell and stone fruit and the acidity is crisp, balancing the richness of the palate. - France	£6.50	£37
Terre Antiche, Gavi de Gavi	Made with grapes from two outstanding vineyards, this is a classic, Gavi di Gavi. A floral nose leads into citrus fruits and apples on the palate. There are nutty notes in the background. The finish is all about grapefruit. - Italy		£37
Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc	The best-known name in New Zealand wine, Cloudy Bay is the "standard bearer of Marlborough winery's." Ripe, complex and elegant gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf aromas. - New Zealand		£50
Domaine du Nozay, Sancerre	Ripe grapefruit aromas which are also very limestone and flinty in character. Attractive mouth filling texture with real substance and breadth. Quite a serious style here which shows in the finish, charged with zippy, crunchy structure. - France		£45



Ponte Milano, Negroamaro, IGT	Bright ruby red, with some purple highlights, it presents fruity, floral and delicately spicy scents in the nose. Vigorous and full-bodied in the mouth, with acidity and a tannic structure that are decisive but never overpowering. - Italy	£3.50	£19
Lorosco, Reserva, Merlot	Intense fresh fruity aromas of blackberries and plums, intermingled with soft toasty notes and sweet vanilla. Medium-bodied, soft tannins and a pleasant finish. - Chile	£4	£23
Baron de Badassière, IGP Pays d'Oc, Syrah	Deep red colour, with complex spicy aromas leading to a structured palate, supple tannins and persistent length. Balanced with freshness that lifts the finish. - France	£4.50	£25
Chamuyo, Malbec	Ripe bramble and spicy blackberry notes on the nose are echoed on the richly textured palate, with hints of vanilla oak and balanced acidity on the finish. Ideal with grilled red meats or spicy pasta dishes. - Argentina	£5	£29
Little Yering, Shiraz Viognier	Rich plum and blackberry aromas with an array of spice and hints of viognier. - Australia		£29
C&B reserve, Claret	Fleshy, robust, full of ripe black fruit accented with hints of mocha, smoke and toast. Plenty of fine tannins providing grip and savory texture. - France		£31
Vignobles Gomet, Côtes du Rhone	Perfectly balanced palate with spicy liquorice, dark fruit and a fresh acidity. Rustic, yet elegant on the finish, this wine is exceptional! - France		£33
Izadi Reserva, Rioja	A 100% Tempranillo aged 14 months in American and French oak, an outstanding value showing beautiful black and red currant fruits, high-quality, unsmoked cigar tobacco, liquorice and loamy soil undertones. Deep, medium to full-bodied. - Spain	£6.25	£35
Allegrini, Valpolicella Classico	Vibrant ruby red in color with fresh cherry and plum aromas. This is an excellent accompaniment to Mediterranean cuisine and is the perfect red wine match for fish. - Italy		£35
Vina Mar, Reserva, Pinot Noir	Tense and tight with lovely aromas of flowers, wet earth and sweet spices. Quite "Old World" in style, there is good concentration and energy here on the back of the savory notes. A great food wine. - Chile		£36
Vieux Chevalier, Chateau-neuf du Pape	This deep red wine is complex and elegant with aromas of red currants, red cherries, black berries with spicy overtones such as lavender, thyme and rosemary. The wine shows very subtle oaky notes, bringing complexity and length. the tannins are elegant and silky. - France		£53

Pez de Rio, Granach/Syrah	This full-bodied rosé is made from Garnacha (also known as Grenache) and Syrah grapes. It has a lively pink colour and is a crisp, easy drinking wine is red berry flavours. – Chile	£3.50	£19
Montevento, Pinot Grigio Blush	Raspberry pink colour, with intense and bright summer berry character. The palate is ripe, soft and juicy. - Italy	£4.25	£25

Chateaux Delmond Sauterns	Pale gold in colour with fresh floral and stone fruit aromas on the nose. Apricot, honey and peach mix with citrus peel and creamy flavours on the palate. Medium to full in body with refreshing acidity to balance the sweet finish - France	£4.00/7.50	£45
